

Chemistry Transfer Student Scholarship

The LACC Chemistry Department will award a \$1000 scholarship to a student who will be transferring next fall or winter as a prospective major in chemistry, biochemistry or chemical engineering.

The requirements are:

1. ...at least 30 units completed at LACC through Fall 2008
2. ...completion of, or current (Spring 2009) enrollment in, Chemistry 212
3. ...completion of at least 10 additional units of chemistry at LACC
4. ...a minimum overall GPA of 3.0
5. ...a minimum GPA of 3.0 in chemistry classes
6. ...a completed application form
7. ...two letters of recommendation, with at least one from a science or math instructor at LACC
