LORRAINE WYLER MATH SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Sponsoring Department: Math

Award Amount: \$1,000

Criteria for Applying:

- 1) Female student at LACC who is currently a Mathematics major (as defined by the Mathematics Department) who needs 12 units or fewer to complete all LACC requirements for the Mathematics major. Applicants may transfer in two semesters or requirements from another college
- 2) Has been a full-time student at LACC, carrying 12 units or more in at least two of four semesters of attendance
- 3) Has a GPA in all mathematics subjects of 3.5 or greater and or has outstanding mathematical ability; has a GPA in all other subjects of 3.0 or greater
- 4) Is planning to transfer to a four-year college or university as a mathematics major

Requirements: An essay describing why the candidate wants the award, why the candidate deserves the award, and a description of the candidate's future goals

The Lorraine Wyler Story

Paul Wyler established this award, in memory of his beloved late wife, Lorraine Wyler. Lorraine Wyler graduated from the City College of New York in 1955, with an emphasis in education and geology. After the completion of her M.A., she taught Biology, Earth Science, and Mathematics at Los Angeles City College. In addition to the classes she taught on campus, Wyler was also a student and performer in the LACC Music Department.
